National Service Scheme (Unit No. 26 & 74)

The NSS Units of PSMO College have conducted innumerable innovative programmes during the year 2017-18 under the leadership of the programme officers, Dr. Roopesh N. Asst. Prof of Mathematics and Mr. Kaberali P, Asst. Prof. of English. The NSS volunteers planted 50 tree saplings in the campus and conducted an oath taking to protect nature and environment as part of the **World Environment Day Celebration** on 05th June 2017. The programme was inaugurated by college Principal Dr. K Azeez. **An awareness Class on Monsoon Induced Diseases** was arranged on 08th June 2017, in which Mr. Mujeeb Rahman, Junior Health Inspector, Tirurangadi PHC, handled the class, and on the following day a **Health Survey and an awareness Campaign against Monsoon Diseases** was conducted among 400 families in the nearby areas of the college.
