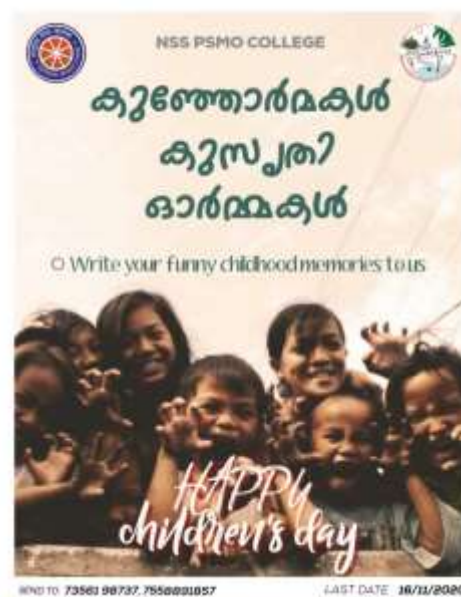
9. NSS DAY CELEBRATION

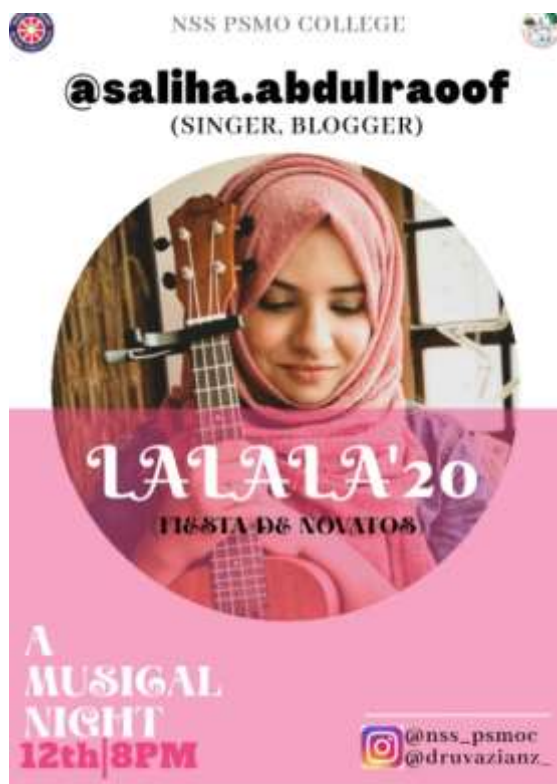
12.WEBINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS DAY
