Abstract

Higher Education Department – Private Aided Colleges – Fixation of workload for teaching staff in Aided Arts and Science colleges - Norms revised – Orders issued

HIGHER EDUCATION (D) DEPARTMENT G.O.(Ms)No.155/2020/HEDN Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 01/04/2020

Read 1 G.O.(F)No.5/2001/H.Edn dated 03/01/2001 2 G.O. Ms)No.93/2018/H.Edn dated 9/5/2018

ORDER

Government, vide order read as 2nd above, have issued order with respect to minimum requirement of workload for each teaching post in Aided Arts & Science colleges.

2. On further examination, Government have found that the criteria applied in the Government order above are not in line with the UGC Regulations 2010 adopted by the State and which are applied to Government Colleges in the State. Besides, the application of those criteria will incur huge financial burden to the State which can not be borne at the present juncture of financial crisis.

3. In these circumstances, Government have re-examined the matter in detail. The Government Order read as 2nd Paper above is hereby modified by deleting the para (3) for fixing the workload of teaching posts in the Arts and Science Colleges and by incomorating the following criteria;

(i) In all Aided Arts and Science Colleges in the State, workload of 16 hours per week is required for sanctioning and filling up of regular teaching posts. No regular teaching post will be allowed for a workload of less tues 16 hours, even if it is a single faculty subject. Service of Guest lecturer alone will be permitted for subjects with a workload of less than 16 hours.

(II) It is also ordered that existing teachers whose appointments have already been approved will not be terminated on this account, even if they have less than 16 hours of workload now. The posts existing with less than 16 hours of workload will vanish away on the retirement/resignation/relieving of the present teacher or occurrence of vacancy in any other manner. No Manager is permitted to fill up any teaching post which carries less than 16 hours of workload.

(iii) PG weightage will not be considered since it is not provided under UGC Regulations.

4. These modified criteria will come into force with effect from 09/05/2018. The orders read as paper 1st and 2nd above are modified to the above extent.

Consequent on de-linking of Pre-Degree from colleges Juring 1.97. a large number of teaching staff in the Arts and Science Colleges were rendered surplus due to reduction in workload. Those teachers who were not qualified to teach Under Graduate and Post Graduite Colleges were deployed to Government (hober Secondary Schools. The others here retained in the respective Colleges and allowed to continue in supernumerary posts and were termed as fexcess' teachers. They were paid pay and allowances by the Government. Apart from these and other measures, Government sanctioned approximately 440 Courses on the specific condition that there will be no financial controlitement to Government. This was with the interport to vide work to the excess teachers. Accordingly, the workload of these Courses was not atomed to be reckoned for creation of new posts/vacancies. Moreover, fresh appointments to Prive te colleges were banned.

2. Students were being admitted to these conditional (out as, and reachers were engaged by the managements themselves to conduct these Courses. The services of excess teachers were also utilized. With more and more teachers others, how service, it became impossible to run these Courses as well as the regular Course. Quality of education could not be achieved at the desired level as most of the possistenders it acant
