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## PREFACE

**Pocker Sahib Memorial Orphanage College** was established in July, 1968 as an aided junior college, affiliated to the University of Kerala under the management of the Tirurangadi Muslim orphanage committee (Regd.). Consequent upon the University re-organization, the college came under the University of Calicut in the same year. It was upgraded as a first grade college in 1972 and a Post Graduate College in 1981. Three of the Departments have been recognized as Research Centres. It has emerged as one of the premier institutions of higher learning under Calicut University in terms of infrastructure, programmes, staff and student strength. At present, ten Under Graduate programmes and seven post graduate programmes are offered at the college catering to the higher educational needs of around 1800 regular students and around that much part time students through the IGNOU study centre. The college has completed 53rd year of its academic journey. Throughout this journey the college have been vigilant in providing quality education to the students. It enables them to develop all of their attributes and skills to achieve their potential as human beings and members of society. Through scientific application of educational psychology, effective class room management, proper evaluation techniques, inculcation of research aptitude and overall by a systematic educational administration this goal can be achieved to a great extent. Since its inception in 1968, PSMO College Tirurangadi, has continually strived to provide quality education to the socially and educationally backward people of Malappuram and nearby districts of Kerala State. The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) of this college plays a key role in ensuring the standards of education provided in this institution. 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## Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report

The College maintains a powerful online feedback mechanism. Feedbacks of the performance of the teachers and that of the programme and campus facilities are usually carried out at the end of each semester. The responses in the feedbacks are analysed by the IQAC and suggestions are made for further improvement. Feedback on the performances of teachers will be communicated to them online. They were asked to prepare and keep their consolidated feedback grade sheet in each semester in their personal profile and modify the teaching procedure so as to improve the weak points. The analysis of feedback on campus

and programme as a Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is given below where the responses are presented in percentage. Besides the student satisfaction survey feedback on curriculum are taken the following stake holders

- i) Students
- ii) Faculty members
- iii) Alumni
- iv) Employers

#### ATR on Student Satisfaction

1. The overall grading of student satisfaction survey in four point scale for the college was found to be 3.25. The score is found to be satisfactory. However measures are taken for further improvement of this grading.
2. Specific feedback by students to teachers were send to the teachers and they were asked to improve their weak points as per the feedback
3. Overall survey score in student satisfaction is satisfactory for the college.
4. Recommendation to improve the established learning management system (LMS) for the college has been discussed with the faculty members in charge and necessary modifications are done to the learning management system. The recommendation of the students to make the library book available during lock down where taken into consideration and necessary arrangements were done.
5. It was decided to continue promotion of peer learning, combined learning and inclusive learning of students as per the analysis of the feedback and specific comments of students in the feedback.



## ATR on Feed Back on Curriculum

1. The overall grading of feedback on curriculum by students, faculty, alumni and employers on a five point scale were 4.2925, 4.235, 4.3863 and 3.6578 respectively. The scores shows a gradual increase comparing with the same in the last year except the feed back from employers. This is expected to be because of the modifications amendments made in the syllabus by the university. However further improvements are required in the curriculum by taking into consideration the demands of the employers. This require a consultation of the curriculum structuring committee of the university with the requirements of the industries and employers. The college has decided to overcome this by offering new add on / certificate course with specific course outcomes. Since the college is affiliated to the University of Calicut, there are restrictions for the college to modify the Curriculum. However the following measures are taken positively from the side of the IQAC and institution to improve the quality of curriculum, so that it will be more promising to cater to the student diversity, industrial needs of employers, and expectations as per the demand of the alumni and faculty. Once the college is able to bag academic autonomy it is expected that further freedom in this regard can be achieved.
2. The college through Governing council and IQAC has encouraged faculty members of the college to take part in the syllabus modification workshops and symposiums of the affiliating University. Many faculty members of various departments of the college has actively participated in these workshops.
3. It is decided to increase the number of specific Add on / Certificate courses so as to cater to the requirements of the stake holders and society.
4. Departments has taken this step positively and a good number of subject specific and general certificate courses are being organised by each department.
5. For subject specific certificate course students of the parent department can apply whereas student of any department can attend general certificate course.
6. Recommendations are made by the IQAC about addition of some topics and deletion of some existing topics of curricula of various discipline in consultation with the faculty members of the discipline.
7. Faculty members of the college who are members of academic council, chairpersons of board of studies of the affiliating university were assigned to represent these recommendations in the relevant curriculum development related body.

8. The IQAC has also made a recommendation of modifying the syllabi to be more outcome based with course outcome and programme outcome being included in the syllabus including those of add on / certificate courses.
9. IQAC encouraged the faculty members to participate in the syllabus review workshop of the affiliating university and various affiliating colleges to their newly approved courses in the back ground of COVID -19 outbreak.
10. Measures are taken to include field study and industrial visit to relevant programmes in a more effective manner.


