IN MEMORIAM

T K MUHYUDDIN UMARI SAHIB

Blessed to be born in 1943 at Tirurangadi as a son to the great freedom fighter and renowned leader of Kerala Renaissance, K M Moulavi and Fathima, the daughter of chalilakath Kunhahammed Haji, the promulgator of Modern Madrassa Movement, T K Muhyuddin Umari's personalty was a harmonious blend of scholarship, humility and leadership. He won wide recognition as a best teacher, author, translator, educationist and leader of organisation. Umari lived many lives leaving behind a great impact on the fields he was involved with. He had been the front-line activist for the cause of Tirurangadi orphanage and allied institutions. He received primary education from his own father and from Nurul Islam Madrassa at Tirurangadi. Umari has graduated with first rank from Darul Uloom College in Umarabad. He started his career as a High School Assistant in Oriental High school, Tirurangadi in 1960. After acquiring degree in Afsal-ul- Ulama, he was posted as lecturer

on deputation from 1976 to 1979 at Valavannur Arabic College. He retired from the service in 1988. He had also made his service available at Jamia Salafiya Arabic College, Pulikkal and UP School at Kuttoor.

He was the founding leader of Kerala Arabic Teachers Federation (KATF) and had been a member of its state committee for many years. He was active in religious, educational and cultural realms and assumed important offices in various organisations such as the Vice President of All India Ahle Hadith; the first President of ISM; member of the State Committee, KNM; President of Bahrain Indian Islam Centre; KNM Text Book Committee Member; President of Tirurangadi Young men's Library. He authored many books such as *Ahkamuthajveed*, *Haj Umra*, *Ziyarath* etc and accomplished many notable translations.

His service was officially rendered to the orphanage from 1986 onwards



when he was nominated as a member of the general body of the orphanage committee. He was elected as the working member in 2002. He became Vice

President of *yatheem khana* committee in 2005, and was elected as the President of the committee in 2013, consequent to the demise of Dr. Alikutty Sahib.

DR. M ABDUL MAJEED

Dr. Abdul Majeed who served as the chairman of the Tirurangadi Orphanage Managing Committee for decades, maintained his familial and emotional bond with the orphanage till his last breath. He began his service as a regular member of the TOMC and attained the heights of glory in assuming the offices of the assistant secretary of the orphanage committee and the member of the governing body of PSMO college. Dr. Majeed sahib was fully involved with the day today affairs of the orphanage - from the annual fund collection for the protection of the orphans, to attending the meetings of the committees of institutions under the orphanage. He has left behind an indelible imprint in the fields of medicine, education, philanthropy, social and cultural realm, which distinguished himself as a highly charismatic figure. His involvement and stance in all matters related to the institution was intact, precise and of no move.

Dr. Majeed Sahib was born on 29 March 1943 in Kozhikode, as the son of Kunhoy Vaidyar, Mullaveedu

and Khadeeja, Thacharakkavil. His father was a scholar and one of the founders of Farook College. Dr. Majeed completed his secondary education as the school topper in 1958 from MM High School, Kozhikode. He had his pre-degree from Farook College and graduation from UC College, Aluva. Subsequently, he went to study medicine at Kozhikode Medical College. He joined Govt. Medical service for the first time in 1968 at Taliparamba, Kannur and in the following year he was appointed as Assistant Surgeon in Govt. Hospital, Malappuram. His marriage with Khadeeja, the daughter of M K Haji, was solemnized in the same year. Having served government medical department for many years, he opted voluntary retirement in 1976 and pursued private medical practice in 1981 and established M B Hospital in Malappuram.

Being the son-in-law of M K Haji, was to the doctor, a window to being associated with *Yatheem khana*, and the bond with the institution continued to exist until the last moment of his life.

It was in 1979 that he became a member of the general body of *yatheem khana* and in 1983 he was appointed as the assistant secretary of the orphanage committee. He made his service available to the inmates of *yatheem khana* until M K Haji Hospital was established at Tirurangadi. His selfless service paved way for him to assume various significant offices which include chairman of Kidney Welfare Society, Malappuram District; general secretary of KNM Zakath Cell; general secretary of Islahia Higher Secondary School, Malappuram; general secretary of Masjid Umer Farook, Kunnummal; the first general secretary of Palliative Care, Manjeri; the founder and leader of Malappuram *Yatheem khana*; the adviser to Integrated Medical Brotherhood, a voluntary organisation of doctors etc. His



association and involvement with the day today affairs of PSMO College was exemplary. Ever since his joining the College Governing Body and the College Interview Board, Majeed Doctor had been providing timely advice on the academic and non academic matters of the college. In spite of his demise on 24 February 2019 at his residence in Malappuram, his life will remain a constant source of inspiration to the generations to come.



INTERNATIONAL SEMINARS



DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

1 Department of History conducted three international seminars during the academic year 2017-18. In honour of the retirement of Dr. PP Abdul Razack, HoD, History, a seminar under the title 'Early Modern and Colonial in History: Concepts and Cases in South Asia' was organised. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. KT Jaleel, Hon Minister for Higher Education, Kerala, through video conferencing. The key note address was made by Dr. Nirmal Ranjith Dewasiri Professor of History, University of Colombo, Sri Lanka. The Seminar was moderated by Prof. Seema Alavi, University of Delhi. Theme-South Asia underwent drastic changes during the eighteenth and nineteenth

centuries, the experiences of which have been perceived and explained differently. Consequently, this period attracted serious attention of the tribe of historians. Studies have come out in commendable number on transformations of South Asian economy, society and culture during the period in question in the last three decades. Conceptual differences, ideological inclinations and methodological variance have produced multiple hues and shades in historiography of the period. The seminar intends to provide a platform for discussion on the nature of changes that the Indian subcontinent and South Asia have undergone in eighteenth and nineteenth centuries.

2 One -Day International Workshop was organized on Multi-modal Ethnography and Oral Histories: Models for Academic Writing on 08 Aug 2018. The programme was inaugurated by Prof. Samuel Mark Anderson, New York University, Abudhabi. The programme was attended by Dr. Neelima Jayachandran, Pennsylvania State University, USA. Mr Rahoof Ottathingal, Researcher, Netherlands led the discussion.

According to Prof Anderson, logistics, ethics and aesthetics are the essential requirements for a good ethnography. Oral history make it a powerful tool for improving broader academic writing skills. Translations of social difference and personal experience to the page bring heightened attention to issues including cultural representation, political activism, the role of primary source evidence, distinctions between opinion and interpretation, and the intersection of academic discipline.

3 As part of the Re-Study of Bake Recordings, the Department of History organised the second edition of Times & Tunes on 10 January, 2019. Prof. Amy Catlin-Jairazbhoy was the chief guest, who delivered a lecture on Traditions & Transgressions Piety and Performance on the West Coast. The programme was organised in honour of the great ethno-musicologist, the late Arnold Bake. Dr. Arnold (Adriaan) Bake (1899-1963), the Dutch Ethno-musicologist who taught at the University of London, was a pioneer in the study of South Asian music and dance. The World and Traditional Music Collection of the British Library holds a unique anthology of materials recorded by Bake. During his musical explorations in South Asia between 1930s -1950s, Dr. Bake had also studied the ritual, cultural and musical landscape of Malabar, including Mappila songs. The Kerala materials are re-studied/ re-recorded by the eminent UCLA ethno-musicologist Prof. Amy Catlin-Jairazbhoy. The Seminar & Film-Discussion, 'Traditions & Transgressions: Piety and Performance on the West Coast' will be followed by the current edition of Re-recording the Bake material.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

8 Department of Economics organised an international seminar on migration in collaboration with the State Planning Board, Government of Kerala on 29 January, 2019. Mr. Sebastian Castelier, an international Journalist, presently pursuing research on migration studies, was the chief guest in the international conference on 'Transnational Migration in Transition-Transformative Characteristics of Migration from Kerala'. Migration is an equilibrium process which reduces regional disparities at different stages of development and a process which is as old as human civilization. Migration from Kerala needs to be analysed as a social process which is closely linked to the current processes of global social transformation in which human agency and social network play a major part. Human migration in the present form started with the oil boom in 1970s especially in gulf countries. In the global era, controversies abound over temporary labour migration. Since the nationalization of jobs in Gulf countries is in full swing, it will turn out to be a severe problem for the overseas Keralites. The emigrants will have to return to their home lands sooner. This is one of the major labour market issues that the State is going to face. The main theme of the conference was sustained socio-economic analysis on a comparative basis, critiquing the underpinning concepts conventionally accepted

as fundamentals in the areas of economic and social transitions in Kerala due to migration, the cultural inter-transfers, headship and the so called 'gulf dream' of Kerala youth.

The conference was inaugurated by Mr. Castlier and in the inaugural address he opined that Kerala emigrants were not only the backbone of Kerala economy, but has been contributing immensely in the development the Middle East. 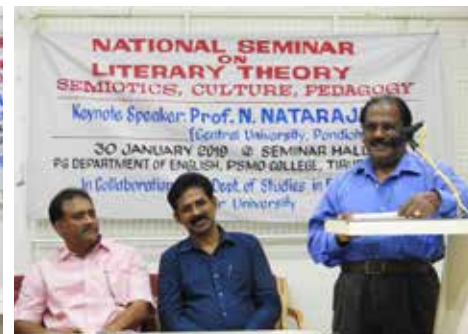

DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

PROPAGATION AND SUPPLY OF PEPPER TO FARMERS

The Department of Botany started the programme 'Karshakarkoru Kaithangu', a programme aimed at providing saplings of high yielding varieties of pepper and other medicinally important spices, to farmers in Tirurangadi Municipality. During the year 2018-19, selected high yielding varieties of pepper including Panniyur 1 were propagated vegetatively after treating with Indole Butyric Acid. Treatment solution was made by dissolving 50 Mg Indole

Butyric Acid in 1 Liter of water. The cuttings were dipped in this solution for one hour and planted in polythene bags filled with soil. This extension work was done as part of the practical works of the students in vegetative propagation of plants by using hormone. The work was carried out in the college green house. Supply of the saplings was done on the basis of a household survey carried out by the students on 31 October 2019.

FEED BACK SESSION

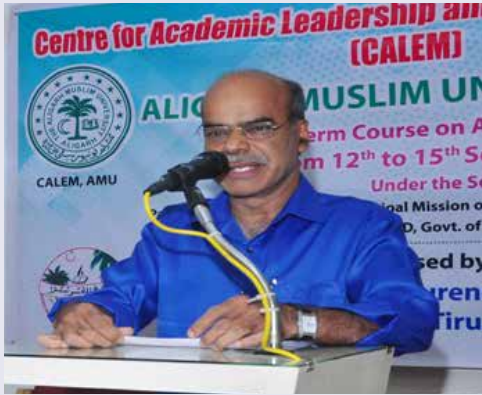

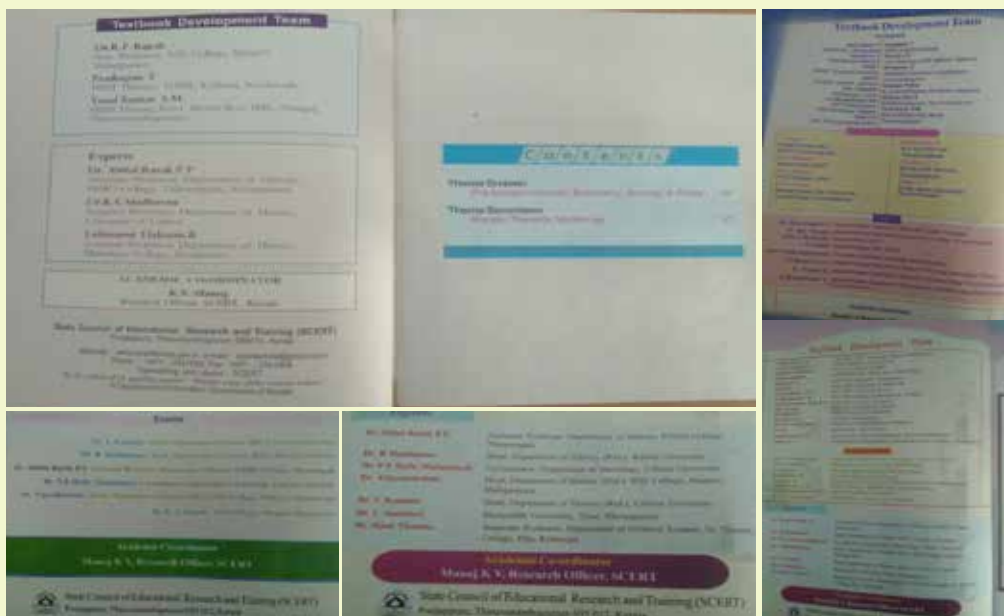

At the end, *In situ* conservation of the germplasm of 8 species of *Salacia* from South India were also established at KFRI and in the wild.

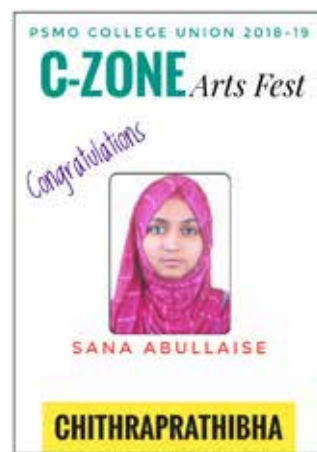
