YES INDIA (Young Ebullient Students India) is a voluntary non profit making organization under CIGI [Centre for Information and Guidance India] Calicut which is working for the educational upliftment of the Malabar region especially the rural backward areas like coastal belt of Malabar. YES India is a student centred programme

run by students and for needy students. YES INDIA runs many programmes like Young Students India, Math India, CS Focus, HR India, Leadership India etc. YES India PSMO Chapter came into existence in the academic year 2019-20 and started the first project *Aksharassamudram*. *Aksharassamudram* is a major project under YES

INDIA intended to provide educational support to the SSLC students (Mentees) living in the coastal area. Eighteen UG Students from PSMO College expressed their willingness to act as the project supporters (Mentors). 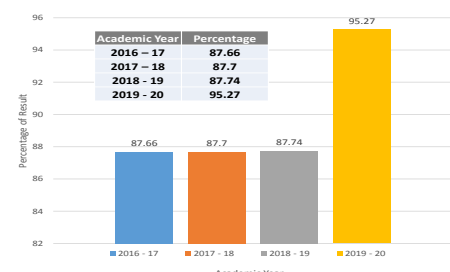

## NSS to act as children's guard

Good response to campaign against child abuse

The National Service Scheme (NSS), a forum on school campuses promoting better social interaction by students, has proved that it could play a significant role in reducing and preventing excesses and abuses against children.

A joint venture between the NSS and the Childline made as part of a campaign against increasing child abuses has given "unbelievable results" by reaching out to more than one lakh people in the district within a few days.

"It was an amazing result. We never expected it. We are going to make a solid impact, thanks to the immense potential of the NSS," said Childline district coordinator C.P. Solem.

The NSS was roped in for a week-long Pink Band campaign that began on the Children's Day on November 14.

"We could reach out to more than one lakh people through 100 NSS units in schools across the district," said NSS district coordinator Suresh Bathery.

The district has most number of children in the State. According to the statistics available with the Health Department, as many as 13.5 lakh children in the district are between 13 and 15 years of age.

Of late, there has been a

sport in child abuse cases in the district. The number of POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offences) Act cases registered in October in the district was the highest perhaps in a single month.

Childline officials said that most cases of abuses reported were among children between 11 and 15 years of age. According to the National Crime Records Bureau, over 90% of the abuses have been from close relatives.

## THE FLOOD AND POST FLOOD ACTIVITIES

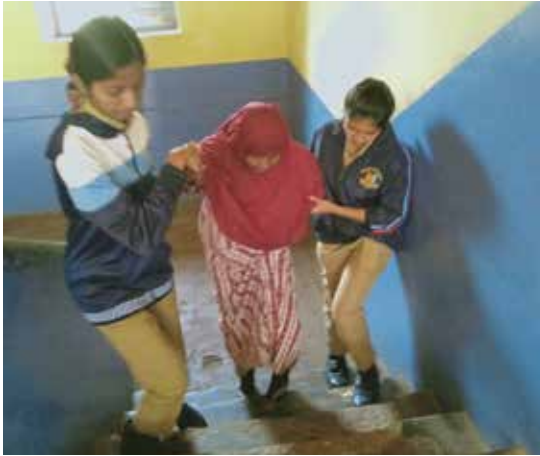
