Dr Anand B. Puthirath received his PhD in physics from Cochin University of Science Technology (CUSAT), India where he studied the roles of surface plasmons and conducting polymers in optoelectronics and energy storage. Dr Anand completed his Masters in Physics from the same school where he specialised in Masters in Physics from the same school where he specialised in modern optics, advanced maths physics and quantum field theory. After receiving his PhD, he joined Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), India as Postdoctoral fellow where with the help of impedance spectroscopy he investigated various types of relaxation phenomena in supercooled glassy liquids near to their glass transition temperatures (Tg) while studying the potential material compositions for flexible salid electrolytes. He received the stational pastdoctoral fall-which in the warp 2017 to pursue national postdoctoral fellowship in the year 2017 to pursue postdoctoral research in Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru. 


CAREER STORMING PROGRAMME




A snap shot of the webinar recording of the interaction between the resource person and the participants.


PSMO COLLEGE LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LMS)






PIC & CORE MENTORS MEET




RADIO TALK


PALLIATIVE CARE ORIENTATION CAMP

YOGA DAY CELEBRATION




ONLINE ONAM CONTESTS


NSS DAY CELEBRATION


KUNJORMMAKAL KUSRUTHI OORMAKAL (CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION)


VARAM 2020




NSS ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR FIRST YEAR STUDENTS


TO EQUALITY








CIVIL SERVICES ACADEMY

The academy organized an online interactive session with on 1 November, 2020.







Sri. Hamza Koya had been in PSMO College in the period 1974 to 1977. During the period he represented College football and Volleyball teams in Inter University level besides being proved his mettle in long jump and other athletic events. He was included in the Calicut University Football team in the academic year 1976-77. He was the most promising player the college had ever seen. Soon after his college days, he played for Western Railway (1977-79), Union Bank of India (1981-82), RCF Mumbai (1983-84), TATA Sports Club (1984-85), ORKAY Mills (1986-96) and also played in Santhosh trophy for Maharashtra during 1981-86.

This eminent football player passed away with complications due to COVID-19 on 6 June 2020 at the age of 61 and was unfortunate to become the first victim of the corona virus in Indian sports.

The Alumni Association of PSMO College instituted an ever rolling trophy as a tribute to the great alumnus of the College. The handover ceremony of the trophy was conducted at PSMO college on 1 March 2021. Dr. EK Satheesh, the Registrar, University of Calicut and an alumnus of PSMO college, received the trophy from the chief guest, Anas Edathodika, the renowned footballer.
